Your request for information was received on 11th April 2019 and was dealt with under the terms of the Freedom of Information Act 2000. Please be advised that the Business Services Organisation (BSO) has now completed its search for the information you requested with regards Clinical System Contracts within the WHSCT:

- The EPR System contract was extended under review until 30th September 2019.
- It is intended to review this contract on an annual basis.
- The EPR System contract is still in use.
- The information relating to the contract holder has been withheld as this is considered exempt from disclosure under Section 43 of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (Commercial Interests). This is a qualified exemption and is therefore subject to the Public Interest Test, a copy of which is attached for your information.

I hope that the information provided assists you. If you are dissatisfied in any way with the handling of your request, you have the right to request a review. You should do this as soon as possible or in any case within two months of the date of issue of this letter.


