

Verification of your entitlement to be registered for Health and Social Care Services in Northern Ireland

WHY HAVE I BEEN SENT THIS FORM TO COMPLETE

Health and Social Care Services are primarily for the benefit of people who are 'ordinarily resident' in Northern Ireland or eligible visitors who satisfy an exemption under the Provision of Health and Social Services to Persons Not Ordinarily Resident Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2015.

The Business Services Organisation manages the list of patients who are registered with a GP in Northern Ireland and are required to ensure that the information held is up to date, correct and those on the list are entitled to access publically funded health care in Northern Ireland.

In order not to delay the registration process with a GP in Northern Ireland, the Business Services Organisation (BSO) operates a post registration verification process to establish a patient's entitlement. This means that for most people, when they register with a GP they are only required to provide their proof of lawfulness in the UK. The BSO subsequently undertake a verification check using the details you have provided, which means for most patients they are not required to provide any additional documents and we do not need to contact them.

When we have been unable to verify the details we hold using this process, it is necessary for us to write to you requesting that you provide us with your circumstances and supporting documents.

PROVIDING SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATION

You are required to provide copies of supporting documentation, as listed in the enclosed booklet, along with your completed questionnaire.

WHAT DO I NEED TO DO NOW

Northern Ireland is my place of Permanent Residence

Complete the form, answering all the questions and sign the declaration. You need then to refer to page Supporting Documents Booklet and read the list of documents. This is a list of the most commonly used documents which we accept for people who are resident in Northern Ireland. If you do not have any of these documents, please contact us to discuss your circumstances and what documents you have which may be acceptable.

I am no longer Resident in NI

If you are no longer residing in Northern Ireland, please go straight to Section 4 and sign the declaration. We will update your records and advise your GP.

I am a Frontier Worker

If you are a Frontier Worker, i.e. someone who works in Northern Ireland and resides outside the UK, travelling daily between your place of work in NI and your place of residence and wish to be registered with a GP. You should contact us immediately, using the contact details on the our letter, to request an application form to register as a Frontier Worker.

I am a Visitor in Northern Ireland

If you are a Visitor in Northern Ireland and my place of permanent residence is elsewhere. If you have paid the Immigration Health Surcharge to the Home Office, please provide your Biometric Residence Permit

If you do not reside permanently in NI, you are only entitled to access Publically Funded Health Care here during your visit, if you satisfy an exemption under the Provision of Health and Social Services to Persons Not Ordinarily Resident Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2015. This applies even if you were born here and/or previously lived or worked here and/or paid taxes and national insurance contributions and/or hold a British Passport.

You should complete this form including the exemption you wish to benefit under, sign and return the questionnaire along with your supporting documentation as indicated in the Supporting Documents Booklet. Alternatively you may wish to contact us and we can advise what is required in order that you can supply these with your questionnaire.

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Please be aware you are required to provide additional documentation to support the information you provide on this form.

- You must complete fully complete this form and provide supporting documentation from Sections 1 and 2 or 3 of the Supporting Documents Booklet
- If you are not ordinarily resident or an eligible visitor in Northern Ireland please complete Section 4 only.
