A new BNF and BNF *for Children* app is now available!

The BNF has announced the launch of a new app, providing NHS health care professionals with the latest content from the British National Formulary (BNF) and the BNF *for Children* (BNFC).

The new app's design and navigation helps clinicians search and view drug monographs and other treatment information quickly and easily, while the ability to use the app offline ensures the availability of critical drug information wherever you are.

The content follows the same structure as the current BNF print and online editions, with easy navigation through sections on Drugs, Treatment summaries, Interactions, Medical devices, Borderline substances and Wound care.

The app also includes an intuitive interactions checker that makes it easy to identify potentially serious issues between combinations of drugs.

The new app will replace the NICE BNF app. To begin with, both apps will be available in order to allow users time to download and familiarise themselves with the new BNF & BNFC App. Both apps will continue to be updated monthly with BNF content, so you can be confident they contain the latest information.

Key features of the app include:

- BNF and BNF *for Children* accessible from a single app
- Easy to use interactions checker
- Faster content updates
