## Conditions of Payment of 'Enhanced Dental Access and Prevention of Dental Decay in Children Aged 0-10 Years Scheme'

## Clinician Eligibility

- Any dental practitioner on the NI Dental List who accepts children into capitation arrangements
- Foundation dentists not eligible
- Orthodontist not eligible

## **Patient Eligibility**

- Child patient between 0-10 years
- Newly registered with dentist and not currently registered with the practice
- Time frame 1<sup>st</sup> January to 31<sup>st</sup> March 2023 acceptance date with GDP into capitation
- Dentists should submit EDI/Portal claims for acceptance into capitation for this scheme by 12<sup>th</sup> April 2023 (see https://hscbusiness.hscni.net/services/2879.htm)

## **Claims Associated with Scheme**

- One-off fee of £14.30 to be paid for each new patient registration age 0-10 years with acceptance date from 1st January 2023 to 31st March 2023
- Dentists should submit claim immediately after examining the child and claim for any treatment provided after the examination date separately under the normal rules of the SDR
- Off system payment on monthly basis in line with payment schedule for any patient that meets the age and date range as specified above
- Backdated payment for any registrations from 1<sup>st</sup> January 2023
- No SDR code associated with the payment, payment based on new registration with dentist
- Payment is eligible for superannuation
- Payment is eligible for practice allowance calculation
- Payment is not eligible for RSS
