## How do I know if I am eligible to take part?

If you meet the following criteria, and would be interested in getting some support, please speak with your GP Practice, your Community Pharmacist or your Northern Health & Social Care Trust representative or simply contact MEAAP.

### Do I meet the following criteria?

- Aged 65 years and over
- Live alone or with another Older Person, in your own home or in sheltered housing
- Have one of the following long term health conditions:
  - Diabetes
  - Heart Failure
  - Stroke
  - Parkinson's
  - Coronary Heart Disease
  - Respiratory (COPD)
  - Frailty
  - Hypertension
  - Osteoporosis
- Registered with one of the participating GP practices (listed, right)
- Would like to talk about your general health and well-being
- Would like to know about and access the support available in your local community.

### Types of support might include:

Befriending, home security checks, handyman services, energy efficiency checks, benefits advice, transport, health support groups and various local clubs.
