Pharmacy Collect NI Phase 2

Important information for people collecting test kits

- i. It is important to report your results, whether positive or negative.
- ii. If you test positive on your LFD, follow the latest public health guidance on NI Direct.
- iii. A negative result does not guarantee you do not have COVID-19. It is important to continue following government guidelines and restrictions.
- iv. Instructions on how to use the test and report your results are inside the box. (Given that there are a number of brands of test kits available through this service, it is important you read the instructions carefully as it may be different from previous kits you have used).

(Note to pharmacy staff: If a person indicates that they have not previously reported their results, it is particularly important to reiterate the importance of doing so for the new tests being supplied).

- v. You must make a note of the lot number of the test kit used, in case you need to report any incidents related to the device, test instructions, harm or injury. The instructions inside the box give details on how you can report any incidents.

Pharmacy staff must provide a Pharmacy Collect NI patient information leaflet with the LFD test kit if available.
