

## **Pre-Requisites**

- 1. Pharmacy PC to log in to VDI
- **2.** Access to Pharmacy / Vaccine email address
- **3.** Microsoft Authenticator App downloaded from Google Play Store / Apple Store other authenticator apps can also be used.
- **4.** This must be completed with both your Pharmacy and Vaccine email addresses.

#### Section 1 - Connect to VDI


1. Open Microsoft Edge and navigate to the below web address. The below screen will appear <a href="https://vdi.hscni.net/portal/webclient/#/home">https://vdi.hscni.net/portal/webclient/#/home</a>




2. Enter in your pharmacy/vaccine username and password. This will be pharmacy.XXXX or vaccine.XXXX with your pharmacy code replacing the Xs.




3. Log on to your <a href="mailto:pharmacy.XXXX@hscni.net">pharmacy.XXXX@hscni.net</a> email address and you will have received a One Time Passcode, enter this in as shown in the above screenshot and click on Logon.




4. Click on the Microsoft 2FA box




5. Click on HTML5 Client – this opens the VMWare Horizon Web Application




6. Click on your pharmacy/vaccine email – whichever one you have logged in to



7. If the above screen appears, click on OK. It may appear again on the top left-hand side of Edge, if it does click on Allow




#### 8. Click on + Add sign-in method




#### 9. Click on Microsoft Authenticator

## Section 2 – Setup Using Microsoft Authenticator




1. If using the Microsoft Authenticator App which is on an Android Mobile or Apple Mobile phone click on Next.




2. Click on Next




3. Open the Authenticator App on your mobile device and tap on the Plus symbol within the App



4. Tap on Work or school account




#### 5. Tap on Scan QR code



6. Scan the QR code that appears on your own monitor, this will then add the Pharmacy or Vaccine account to the Authenticator App as seen on the below screenshot. Click on Next






7. The above screen then appears to test out the Authentication, a notification will appear on your mobile device and when you tap it, it will bring up the below screenshot asking are you trying to sign in.




8. Input the number displayed on the PC Monitor and tap on Yes



9. Once authenticated the above screen appears. Click on Next

#### **Attaching Mobile Number to Authenticator App**


You may be prompted to attach your mobile number to the Microsoft Authenticator App. This process will not be required if using a different Authenticator App on a Surface Pro/Tablet




Change country code to United Kingdom and put in your phone number minus the 0
at the start beside it. Ensure the Receive a code Radio button is selected and click on
Next




2. If prompted, enter in the characters that appear on your computer monitor and click on Nex



3. Enter in the 6-digit number which you receive by Text Message and click on Next



4. Click on Done and your mobile number will appear as a Sign in Method as shown in the screenshot below



If you have any issues with your Multi-Factor Authentication log a call with the BSO Service Desk for Attention of the Cloud Services Team – include as much detail as possible and any error messages you may be receiving.

If you get a new Mobile phone or Tablet Device, you will need to log a call with the BSO Service Desk to get the Multi-Factor Authentication reset. You will then need to follow these instructions again to set it up again.
