Community Pharmacy Care Home Support Service (CPCHSS)

Thank you to those pharmacies who have participated in the Community Pharmacy Care Home Support Service (CPCHSS).

The purpose of this letter is to out-line the plans for the service in this 2026/27 year and to request completion of a proforma (by MS forms) for those pharmacies who have participated in the service during 2025/26.

Pharmacies previously signed up to the 2025/26 service

- The service will continue in line with the [CPCHSS Service Specification](#) for the 2026/27 year. It is not necessary to complete a new contract for the 2026/27 service. The requirement of the service is that each pharmacy should undertake **two care home visits** each financial year.
- Please complete the [MS Forms proforma](#) by 30th June 2026, for each care home where you provided the service during 2025/26.

New Pharmacies who wish to sign up to the 2026/27 service

- For those pharmacies who have not signed up to the service during 25/26 but who now wish to participate in the 26/27 service, please return by email your completed contract ([Appendix A](#)) to your local office as soon as possible.
- Please note all nursing and residential care homes for whom the service will be provided by the community pharmacy, should be listed on the contract.

- A service agreement form ([Appendix B](#)) should be completed for every care home for which the pharmacy is providing the service. A copy of the agreement form should be retained in the pharmacy.
- Please read the [service specification](#) carefully and ensure that all relevant staff are trained and competent to deliver this service.

Change of care home contract

- During the 2026/27 year, if a community pharmacy no longer provides the routine dispensing service to a particular care home and had been contracted to provide the CPCHSS to that care home, please inform your local office as soon as possible, so that monthly payments for CPCHSS can be stopped.

Service monitoring and post payment verification

SPPG will continue to monitor and review this service. As outlined in the service specification, in the event where SPPG/BSO cannot assure claims relating to the provision of the service, recovery of the payment will be sought.

SPPG have a process for partial recuperation of payments made to community pharmacists who are contracted to provide the service but have not completed the required visits in line with the service specification. This process has been discussed with CPNI, through the Service Development group.
