

SPPG Guidance: **Acceptable Forms of Patient ID**

CPVS - Men B Service

Age cohort

Young people eligible by age will be identified by date of birth as documented in their clinical records (e.g. PMR held in the pharmacy) or through Photographic ID with Date of Birth

Examples of photographic ID with Date of Birth include:

- Passport
- Driving Licence
- Travel Pass
- Electoral Identity Card

Photographic ID which has passed its expiration date is acceptable as long as the patient is still recognisable from the photograph.

Higher Education and Residential Further Education (HERFE)

To be eligible as students in HERFE, people will need to:

- be up to 25 years of age, who will be attending Higher Education or a Residential Further Education (HERFE) Institution)

AND

- Present evidence that they are due to attend HERFE for the first time in the academic year 2026-27 as follows:
 - **official email confirmation of their offer of a place** at their chosen university or college from either the higher education (HE) institution (usually a .ac.uk email addresses in the UK) or the Universities and Colleges Admissions Service (UCAS)
 - **a letter (hard copy or email) confirming they have received an offer of a place** for the 2026/2027 academic year at their chosen university or college
 - **screenshot of their offer of a place** at their chosen university or college from the UCAS Hub

The relevant evidence should include the name of the university or college that they are due to attend, the course code and/or title of the course of study, and confirmation of the offer of a place (either conditional or unconditional).
