Hi,

NISRA have pointed me towards the BSO team as you work with GP registration data and might be able to help. I'm in the C-19 Vaccines and Therapeutics team, we are concerned that we don't have a shared understanding across government who cannot be vaccinated. We don't currently have a firm grip on the population data to be sure it is safe, such as children and pregnant people. Or those who may never be able to get vaccination due to contraindication. We're hoping to get a clearer picture of the size of these groups.

I've been hunting for stats and ONS have estimates for the number of pregnant people for England and Wales but not for NI (or indeed Scotland). Is this something which is tracked?
